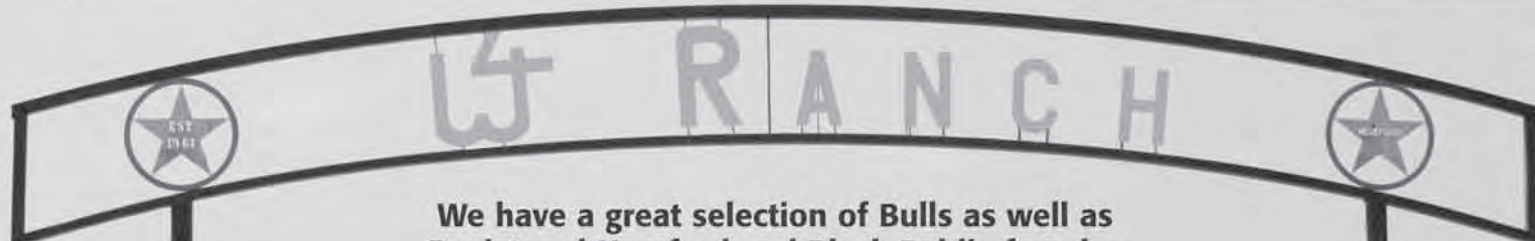

James 'Jim' Munson Gill

Jim Gill departed this life peacefully on September 17, 2011 at the age of 101. Jim was born in Coleman County and remained there until moving to San Marcos in 2008.

Jim was born on April 23, 1910 in Whon, Texas. He was born into the cattle business, grew up in Whon and graduated from Howard Payne College (now University). On November 6, 1931 he married Fay Davis in Brady, Texas. Jim and Fay lived on the Gill Ranch in Whon for 15 years where they first started raising a few head of registered Hereford cattle. This is where they started their Polled Hereford business known as Jim-Fay Hereford Farms. Ten years later in 1941, Jim and Fay started showing cattle and moved their operation north to Coleman in 1945.

Jim's cattle career was illustrious. He was involved in many organizations, including charter member and past president of the Texas Polled Hereford Association, West Texas Polled Hereford Association, National Western Polled Hereford Association, ex-president of Coleman County Breeder Feeder Association and Farm Bureau. Jim served two terms as president of the American Polled Hereford Association. He was a charter member of the Coleman Rodeo Association and honorary vice-president of the Texas State Fair. Jim is a member of the Hall of Fame of the American Polled Hereford Association. He also served as

the secretary for the Brown County Polled Hereford Association, was a member of Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers, and was a member of the Coleman Rotary Club. He was a long-time member of the First United Methodist Church in Coleman.

Jim was preceded in death by his beloved wife Fay in 2003 and also by three brothers. Jim and Fay never had any children of their own. He is survived

by many nieces and nephews, including Kathy Eppers and husband Carl of Muleshoe, Betty Ruth and husband Tony Maciel of San Antonio, Martha Leonora and husband Bill Bond of Chattanooga, Tennessee, Audrey Bailey of Deer Creek, Allyn Gill and wife Bessie of San Marcos, Joyce Gill-England of Bryan, James M. Gill of San Angelo, Leona Sherrod of West Allis, WI, Glenn Lee and husband Steve Shiller of Angerton. ★

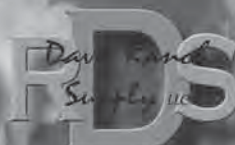

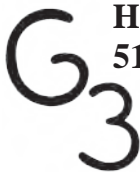
