


Anna Melissa "Chissa" Hogsett Gordon

Many thanks to everyone who showed, consigned, purchased, sponsored or attended this year. It truly takes everyone to make a successful event. Our highest placing heifer scholarship donors made \$7,500.00

available this year and we split it into two scholarships. These donors have pledged to do the same next year. The THA Foundation awarded a \$1000 scholarship and sponsored premiums for the Hereford steer show. Remember we will sponsor our 46th Annual Replacement Whiteface Female sale next year. Now is the time to select and save a pen of ten for the sale which will be held on Sunday, February 1, 2015. 
We had a huge success with a few unique opportunities for members to help themselves and THA. These activities have helped THA establish itself to a sound financial position. We still are operating under a bare essential budget which eliminated any non essential expenses as well as a restricted travel budget. We deeply thank the generous donors and buyers who made such an impact on our finances. I especially wish to thank the donors of the Heritage pen and to everyone who participated in the purchase and donation back to be resold.

The Hereford breed was given some tremendous exposure in the Chevrolet ad that first aired in the first quarter of the Super Bowl on February 2. I think Dickie Garrison, Gamma Ranches of Red Rock, Texas (between Bastrop and Lockhart) deserves recognition for furnishing both the red eyed Hereford bull and the cows that were used in the commercial. If you watch the commercial close enough, you will note that a different Hereford bull was in the trailer at one time. Weinheimer Ranches of Stonewall furnished two bulls that were used in the filming of the commercial. The red eyed bull is registered as MH 7023 Predator X40 and sired by C&M Bounty Hunter 7023 and out of a Hidden Oaks Ranch bred cow sired by KCF Bennett 3008 M326. Morgan Herefords of Giddings and Andrews bred the bull and sold him to Dickie Garrison. Dickie told me they filmed for four days and hauled the cattle from Bastrop to Bartlett as well as on Congress Avenue in Austin. He informed me that some of the film was shot on the McCall Ranch at Bastrop and that the bull stepped out of the trailer at the Capital Livestock barn in Bartlett. Many thanks to Chevrolet and all the people who helped make this commercial.

It is not too early to be preparing consignments to our October sale in Buffalo. We need seventy-five of as good of Hereford bulls as we can find as well as a number of registered and commercial females. We particularly need some baldie and F1 heifers or cows. We will also be selling Red Angus bulls. Now is also time to get cattle picked for our Replacement heifer and Cowtown Select Sale for 2015
